- Geographic representation of CWG members should be improved (only the North West Shelf, Atlantic and Baltic is well represented)
- The members represent only "one perspective" (research institutes)
- There is a missing link to terrestrial services (no members in the CWG represent this)




Opportunites for your ROOS, WG or TT

Threats to your ROOS, WG or TT

- The CWG is a new WG with a lot of energy. Over time this momentum could be lost (actions are being taken against this)
- Some goals might be be too long term or too ambitious
- There are other European initiatives dealing with similar objectives on different levels (e.g. EEA, Copernicus Services, EMODnet). There is a threat that they will cover the objectives of the CWG.



How can the EuroGOOS Office better service the needs of your ROOS, WG or TT?

- The chairs and members have limited resources to cover organizational and communication activities.
 Continued help from EuroGOOS on these aspects is much appreciated.
- The Office should provide visibility of partners (internally and externally) on relevant prestigious events
- The Office should serve as a bridge between ROOSes, WGs, TTs and externally to other initiatives
