



Efficient and fit-for-purpose; Connecting communities; Innovative and adaptable; Stakeholder-driven; Sustainable

#### Main focal areas

- Better Coordinated and Sustained In Situ Ocean Observing
- Close <u>association with the ocean modelling and satellite observation</u> communities to ensure full integration and responding to user needs
- EOVs
- Non-EOVs (other relevant variables, e.g.bathymentry)
- <u>Integrated Ecosystem Approach</u>: from platform-specific observing to multi-platform, integrated and thematic observing





## **Priorities for 2018**

- Requirements and gap analysis:
  - Consolidate requirements in a single place (CIS2 database; EEA)
  - Strong ROOS and TT involvement in formulating requirements
- Sustainability of the observing sytem:
  - Questionnaire in circulation (due late February)
  - Form basis of an update to GISC for estimate of investment in Obs System
  - Sustainability workshop in April/May 2018 to refine assumptions.

### Data policy:

- Does EuroGOOS explore the idea of a new data policy further? Yes
- Possible templates: IOC/JERICO as presented at General Assembly
- Role of data projects that EuroGOOS is engaged in



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## Developing a Blueprint for an Atlantic Ocean **Observing System**

- Strong need to develop a strategy for integrated ocean observing in the Atlantic
- Seek to facilitated a more sustainable, well coordinated, comprehensive system
- Need to better serve societal needs
- System should be sustainable, efficient and fit-for-purpose
- Ambitious, multi-national, multi sectoral, fit-for-purpose
- Should include capacity development and enhance partnerships between science, service, private sector and civil society
- Early 2018 public release of first draft
- The Blueprint will serve as inspiration for the other regional projects who most likely will formulate similar documents
  - Workshop on European Vision planned foe early June 2018
