






EuroGOOS objectives:

- **Strategy**: identify priorities for operational oceanography
- **Promotion**: of O.O. and the necessary research and technology
- **Co-operation**: at global and regional scales (ROOS)
- **Co-production**: of data and model based services
- Coordination: of European contribution to sustained observing systems
- **Representation:** of members to third parties (EU, Int. organizations etc)







- Successful workshop (May 12th and 13th) in Brussels
- Follow up at Maritime Day (Athens)
- Website will be developed
- Start process of interacting with key stakeholders e.g. ICES, JPI, EEA
- Joint Policy document with European Marine Board
- Slides detailing EOOS concept to be prepared and circulated to members in due course

- Chair and SG have selected Dina Eparkhina (formerly of Marine Board) to take over Yota's role
- Secondment agreement with SMHI for Patrick Gorringe remains in place
- Analysis of EuroGOOS commitments to 4 research projects has been completed
- Expect to recruit an additional staff member in coming weeks/months to fulfil scientific deliverables, primarily for AtlantOS
- Chair to provide guidance and remain involved in coordination of EuroGOOS involvement in AtlantOS
